## 2. CASE

### Facts of the case

### Summary of facts of the case

Mr. Jimi Singh SANDHU, an Indian national (victim) was shot dead by the 2 suspects at the Beachfront Hotel Phuket, Thailand on 4th February 2022 at 10.32 PM. According to our investigation and evidence of CCTV footage, the police believed that the suspects are 1) Mr. Gene Kahl LAHRKAMP, Canadian, passport no. HB876301, and 2) Mr. Matthew Leandre Ovide DUPRE, Canadian, Passport no. AD023639. The forensics also found handguns which the suspects used to commit the crime. Our immigration records show that the 2 suspects left the

country on 6th February 2022.

**Additional facts of the case:**

According to our investigation, the 2 suspects tapped Mr. Jimi Singh SANDHU's car by GPS device before the day of incident. On the day of incident, the victim drove his car to his residence while the 2 suspects were waiting near the bush at the hotel with their handguns.

The CCTV caught the scene of 2 suspects that fired their handguns to the body of the victim until dead at scene, then they moved to the another location. The police traced CCTV and found the location that they manage to hide the guns, and later our forensics proof that those handguns linked to their biometrics.
